E. Certification Pay

6. Fleet Services Supervisors who have qualified in a departmentally approved course certified by the CA State Fire Marshall on aerial ladders and pumps unique to fire apparatus equipment, or that are continuing their education in a departmentally approved course of study on equipment unique to fire apparatus shall receive certification pay of 5%. The department head shall approve no more than two Fleet Services Supervisors at any one time to receive the 5% certification pay as outlined in this paragraph.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Resolution.
